## **PROGRESS REPORT**

### PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1 To inform Members of the Overview and Scrutiny Board of the progress made to date by the Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel.

#### RECOMMENDATION

2 It is recommended that the Overview and Scrutiny Board approves the actions of the Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel since the last update, which was presented to this Board at its meeting of 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010.

#### PROGRESS OF THE PANEL

- 3 **Service Update.** As this was the first meeting of the new panel since the Annual meeting, the panel received an outline from the Head of Community Protection on the core function of the Environment Department with specific attention to Community Protection and Leisure.
- 4 **Work Programme.** The panel considered a report at its meeting on 16<sup>th</sup> June, which contained 26 items being proposed for the panel to consider. These were in addition to the subjects raised at the meeting. The panel concluded

with an agreed list of 6 subjects. These are contained within a separate report being presented to the Board for consideration at this meeting.

5 **Designated Public Place Order (DPPO).** The panel has a meeting scheduled for 23<sup>rd</sup> June, which is following the distribution of this report. At that meeting the panel is scheduled to receive evidence from Neighbourhood Safety Team, the Warden Service and also Trading Standards. The panel is also expected to receive Member feedback on their engagement with the public who live around alcohol free zones and the impact DPPO may have.
