PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

BACKGROUND

- The Social Care and Adult Services Scrutiny Panel continues with its investigation into Personal Budgets and has met on one occasion since the last update report was provided.

A demonstration was also given of how another local authority has developed a specific website to signpost people to services.

- 6. The panel will be holding its next meeting on 22 July 2010 where it will be receiving an update in respect of its previous review into Improving Levels of Employment for People with Disabilities.
