- 4 **Designated Public Place Order (DPPO).** The panel has received a range of information during this scrutiny into DPPO's concluding with a meeting with the Mayor. The panel will be discussing their findings at their next meeting, which is scheduled for this month where the panel is intending to identify their conclusion and proposals.
- 5 **Licensing Policy.** The panel received the Review of Licensing Act 2003 Policy Statement to their meeting of 1st September. The panel noted the detail and concluded it was not an area to undertake a full scrutiny. The panel has

asked the service to feed back details of the consultation on the Review of the Draft Licensing Act 2003 when available.
