- 4 **Licensing Policy.** The panel received the Review of Licensing Act 2003 Policy Statement to their meeting in September. The panel is scheduled to receive an update at their meeting scheduled for 27th October following the consultation on the Review of the Draft Licensing Act 2003.

- 5 **Dog Control.** The next subject on the Scrutiny panels work programme is Dog Control (Policies and restraint in public areas). The panel will be receiving evidence from the Environment Department re Legislation, Dog Control and Enforcement and also the practical experiences from the Dog Warden.
