- 3. Since the last update to OSB the Children and Learning Scrutiny Panel has met once, on 24 March 2011.
- 4. At that meeting, the scrutiny panel considered information on the 2011-12 Corporate Management Framework. The submitted report outlined:
 - How the performance management framework contributes to the Council's Strategic Plan.
 - Changes which have been made to the national performance monitoring framework, including a significant reduction in the number of performance indicators (PIs), as a result of the change of Government in 2010.
 - The key elements of the revised framework.
 - The key indicators that are proposed to be developed further in respect of the Children, Families and Learning Department and the Middlesbrough Children's Trust.

- The improvement priorities that have been identified to support development of the performance indicators.
- 5. The meeting also considered an update on the results of OFSTED inspections across all of Middlesbrough's schools since 2006, together with detailed results for inspections carried out during 2010.
- 6. In terms of the panel's remaining meeting before the forthcoming local elections, arrangements are being made for the scrutiny panel to consider:
 - An update on the Building Schools for the Future (BSF) programme.
 - An report on the Council's duty (under the Child Poverty Act 2010) to prepare a Child Poverty Needs Assessment to inform the development of a local Child Poverty Strategy.
