### COMMUNITY SAFETY and LEISURE SCRUTINY PANEL PROGRESS REPORT

#### PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1 To inform Members of the Overview and Scrutiny Board of the progress made to date by the Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel.

#### RECOMMENDATION

- 2 It is recommended that the Overview and Scrutiny Board approves the actions of the Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel since the last update, which was presented to this Board at its meeting of 8<sup>th</sup> March 2011.

#### PROGRESS OF THE PANEL

- 3 **Previous Reports “Progress” - CCTV.** The panel had agreed that the next meeting should focus on previously agreed recommendations of the panel, which had been adopted by the executive and for the panel to assess the actual impact the recommendation had, once implemented.
- 4 The panel looked at decisions taken over the last 2 years and selected the Scrutiny into CCTV. The panel met on the 9<sup>th</sup> March and assessed each Action individually and was satisfied with the progress achieved against each recommendation. The panel also received an update on the development of the CCTV system since the panel had undertaken its Scrutiny.

- 5 The next meeting of the panel is to be held on the 30<sup>th</sup> of March which is following the distribution of this report but in advance of the OSB meeting. The panel is to be presented with the proposed performance 2011–12 indicators at this meeting. The panel will have the opportunity to enquire which indicators are carried forward from the previous government's requirement. Which are statutory indicators and which have been determined by the service. Also how the proposed indicators will be focused and monitored. Consequently, I will report verbally at the meeting, to appraise Members on this item
