# - PROGRESS REPORT

#### **PURPOSE OF THE REPORT**

1. To provide members of the Overview and Scrutiny Board (OSB) with an update on the work of the Environment Scrutiny Panel.

# **RECOMMENDATION**

2. That the Overview and Scrutiny Board notes the updated position.

## **BACKGROUND**

- 3. Since the last update to OSB, the Environment Scrutiny Panel has met once, on 9 February 2012.
- 4. At that meeting, Members considered a draft final report on the scrutiny topic of highway and carriageway works by the utilities companies. This is included elsewhere on the OSB meeting agenda.
- 5. The panel also considered information from the Assistant Director, Environment, on the impact of current and proposed budget reductions on front line services, service standards and staffing.
- 6. It was explained that, in 2012-13, the Environment Department would need to make savings of £1.5m in respect of Environment Services, plus a further £800k in Community Protection.

- 7. Management costs have been significantly reduced through early retirement/voluntary redundancy. While performance and service standards would continue to be monitored on a monthly basis, it was inevitable that this level of budget reduction would affect future service provision.
- 8. The panel is to be kept informed as budget reduction proposals are finalised.
- 9. The scrutiny panel is next scheduled to meet on 5 March 2012 and will begin examination of the new scrutiny topic of maintenance of natural woodland and highway trees.
