3. Since the last report to OSB, the Environment Scrutiny Panel has met twice, on 10 September and 1 October 2012. Details of those meetings are shown below.

10 September 2012

4. The panel considered information from a representative of the Fabrick Housing Group concerning energy reduction and carbon reduction measures. This was in the context of the panel's investigation of action taken in these areas/environmental awareness of public bodies - such as the University, Police and NHS. The panel hopes to ultimately produce a final report highlighting examples of best practice, for dissemination among the bodies that have been involved in the exercise.

1 October 2012

- 5. The panel considered information from the Assistant Director, Environment Services on current and possible joint working arrangements between Tees Valley and other authorities. The submitted information covered a number of areas including:
 - Waste Management Contract
 - Traffic signal maintenance
 - Laboratory and metrology services
 - Arboricultural services
 - Street lighting
 - Fleet management and vehicle maintenance
