- 4. The Panel is next scheduled to meet on 23 October 2012, to start its work into Children with Complex Needs. The meeting is intended to act as an initial 'setting the scene' for the Panel, providing introductory information on Children with Complex Needs. It is also intended to provide sufficient information for the Panel to identify the lines of enquiry it would like to pursue.
- 5. The Panel is also scheduled, in the next couple of meetings, to consider the developing area of Integrated Care, Winter Preparedness and the prevalence of Asbetos related conditions in Middlesbrough.
