## - PROGRESS REPORT

#### PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1. To provide members of the Overview and Scrutiny Board (OSB) with an update on the work of the Environment Scrutiny Panel.

#### RECOMMENDATION

2. That the Overview and Scrutiny Board notes the updated position.

#### BACKGROUND

- 3. Since the last report to OSB, the Environment Scrutiny Panel has met twice, on 4 March and 15 April 2013.
- 4. The scrutiny panel's investigation of the topic of dog fouling is ongoing, with information considered at these meetings shown below.
- 5. On 4 March 2013, the panel:
  - Agreed the terms of reference for its investigation.
  - Heard information on the Green Dog Walker Scheme operating in Hemlington.
  - Considered details of the number of reports of dog fouling, including trends.
  - Heard from Officers from Area Care in respect of that service's involvement with the issue, including the impact of staffing and service reductions.

- 6. On 15 April 2013, the panel heard from the Council's Environmental Protection Manager regarding:
  - Estimated dog numbers in Middlesbrough (1 in 3 houses approximately 20,000 dogs).
  - The link between stray numbers and levels of fouling.
  - Current enforcement processes and numbers.
  - Available resources, including staffing reductions due to budget pressures.
- 7. The scrutiny panel's next meeting is scheduled for 13 May 2013, when a draft final report on this topic will be considered.
