# CHILDREN AND LEARNING SCRUTINY PANEL

## - PROGRESS REPORT

#### PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1. To provide members of the Overview and Scrutiny Board (OSB) with an update on the work of the Children and Learning Scrutiny Panel.

#### RECOMMENDATION

2. That the Overview and Scrutiny Board notes the updated position.

#### BACKGROUND

- 3. Since the last report to OSB, the Children and Learning Scrutiny Panel has met once, on 7 May 2013. The scrutiny panel's investigation of the topic of deprivation and attainment is ongoing.
- 4. The agreed terms of reference for the panel's investigation focus on:
  - Measures of deprivation.
  - Deprivation in Middlesbrough.
  - Trends on attainment in deprived areas of Middlesbrough.
  - The role and involvement of the local authority and other agencies in this issue, including intervention projects and programmes.
  - How progress is monitored/measured.
  - Relevant guidance.

- 5. At the 7 May meeting, the panel examined the impact of action taken to date on attainment levels. Information was considered in respect of:
  - How deprivation is measured.
  - Correlation between affluence and attainment.
  - How statistical information on deprivation/attainment is then used to target resources.
  - The use and impact of the Pupil Premium.
  - The future role of local authorities in challenging schools on performance.
  - The link between poverty and other challenging family issues.
- 6. At the panel's next meeting, it is hoped to speak to local organisations involved in child poverty, such as the William Sutton Trust and/or Joseph Rowntree Foundation.
