The panel received information on the processes the Council has in place to address the issue of Child Sexual Exploitation and specifically what preventative work was being undertaken and what happens when a vulnerable child is identified.
- 4. The panel agreed their terms of references as follows
 - a. Assess the level of the problem of exploited children in Middlesbrough
 - b. Assess how effective relevant agencies are in arresting growth and combating the problem.
 - c. Identify areas where the Council or other agencies can contribute to tackling the exploitation of children.

5. The panel's next meeting is scheduled for 9 April, where a round table discussion has been organised with a number of agencies, including Barnardos, the Local Safeguarding Children Board and the Integrated Youth Support Service.
