CONSIDERATION

Health Scrutiny Panel

- 3. The panel met on 24 February to receive an update from a number of healthcare professionals and private sector providers on Neurological Services in Middlesbrough, following the panel's initial review of the topic in January 2012. At the meeting the panel were told by the professionals that there was a need for paediatric neuro rehab services for children both nationally and in Middlesbrough. The panel were also told that it would be helpful if Neuro Rehabilitation was higher up on the CCG agenda. It was therefore agreed that the panel would seek the views of the CCG on this issue. The CCG and associated health care professionals have been invited back to the panel to enable Members to further investigate this issue.
- 4. The panel also met on 16 March to consider further information on the panel's investigation of GP provision in Middlesbrough, particularly the concern about long term workforce planning issues, GP recruitment, retention and retirement and the increasing demand for GP appointments. Whilst the panel were told that the number of GPs was not at a crisis point, action needed to be taken now and the panel heard about a number of initiatives which were being implemented by the South Tees CCG and

Health Education North East. A final report and recommendations will be submitted to the panel's next meeting.
