# COMMUNITY SAFETY & LEISURE SCRUTINY PANEL - PROGRESS REPORT

#### PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1. To provide members of the Overview and Scrutiny Board (OSB) with an update on the work of the Community Safety and Leisure (CSL) Scrutiny Panel.

## **BACKGROUND**

- 2. The Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny last met on 12 September 2016.
- 3. The panel has selected 'Street Beggars' as its first review topic for 2016/17 and representatives from a range of organisations including Cleveland Police, Thirteen and Middlesbrough Council have been invited to attend the panel meeting to discuss this issue.
- 4. It is intended that the meeting will focus on three key areas as follows:
  - The impact of anti-social behaviour / crime perpetrated by beggars
  - The source of the issue i.e. drugs / alcohol
  - The support available homelessness advice / provision of drug and alcohol treatment programmes
- At the time of writing this report the panel meeting is yet to be held. A verbal update on the evidence received by the panel will therefore be provided at the OSB meeting.
