## PROCUREMENT – MEMBERS' TRAINING

#### BACKGROUND

- 3. The Council is an organisation, which spends over £100,000,000 per year. One important aspect of that expenditure is the need to ensure that the money is correctly spent and that there is a transparent audit trail.
- 4. All authorities have financial regulations and contract standing orders, which are essential to ensure that not only is malpractice not permitted, but also that there is no perception of malpractice.
- 5. Whilst Officers regularly receive training and updates regarding the procurement process, Members have not had such training. However, on the 30<sup>th</sup> November, a training session was held for Members, and copies of the slides from that training session are attached to this report as Appendix 1.
- 6. The Council has also produced a guide to procurement and that is also attached as Appendix 2.

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
