# Skills and Post-16 Education Bill

## Currently under review to:

- local skills improvement plans;
- to make provision relating to further education;
- to make provision about functions of the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education and relating to technical education qualifications;
- to make provision about student finance and fees;
- to make provision about assessments by the Office for Students;
- to make provision about the funding of certain post-16 education or training providers; and for connected purposes

# Why is government action or intervention necessary?

- Too many people leave full-time education with low skills – and too few have higher technical skills (i.e. level 4-5)
- Participation in lifelong learning is low and declining
- Too much learning is done in subjects with relatively low economic value

# Post 16 Provision in Middlesbrough

- Ofsted graded Good
- In 2019 over 2200 apprentices find employment across Teesside and the North East
- Last year 1300 students applied to University with students going on to Durham, Leeds, Manchester, Newcastle, LMU and many more
- At least 97% of our students' progress on to positive destinations when they complete their college course including higher education, apprenticeships or employment
- The quality of education means that 99.6% overall pass rate for A Level subjects

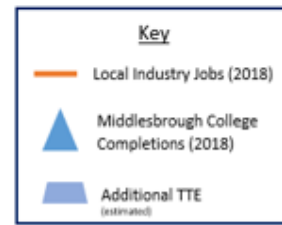
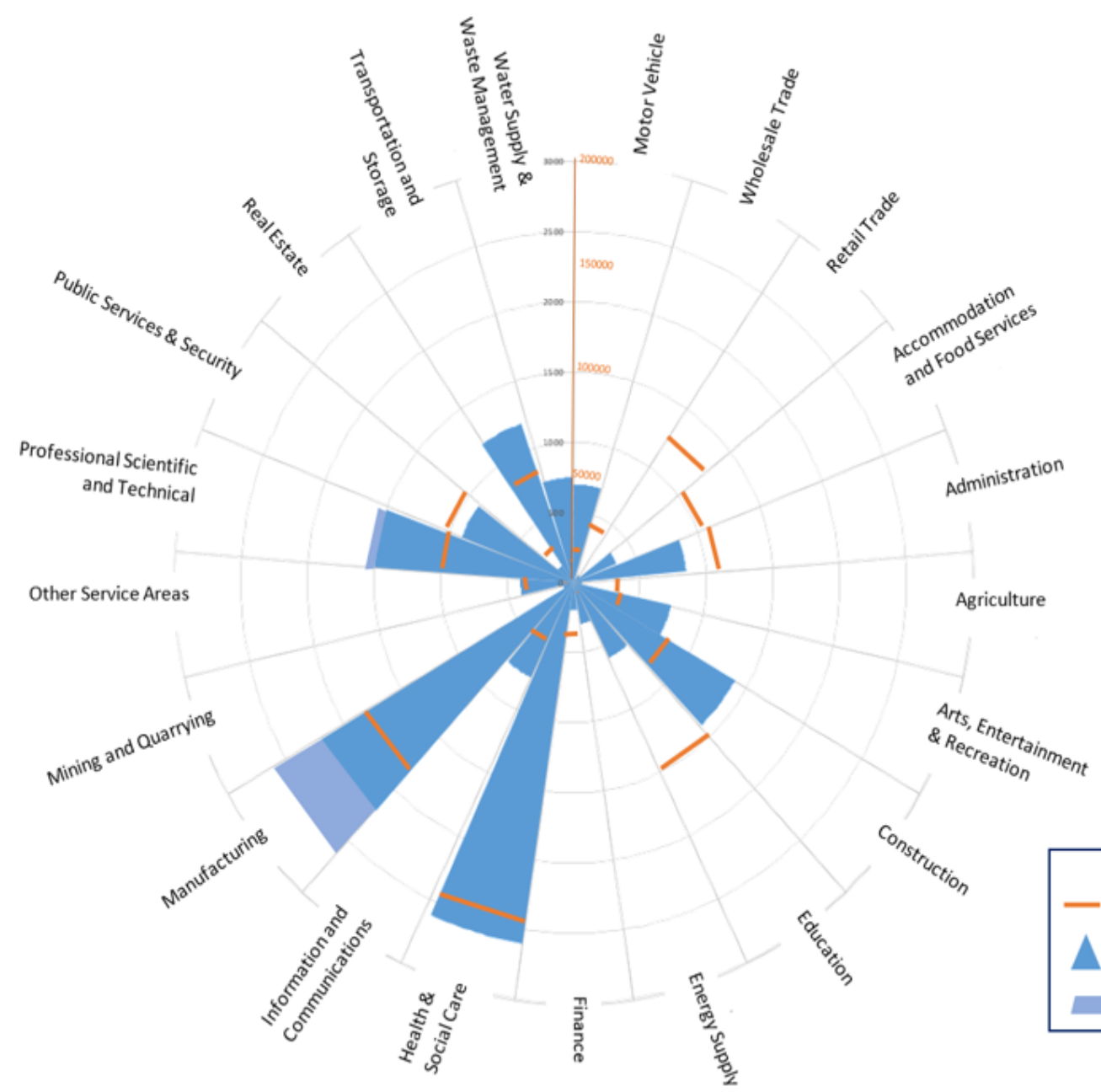
## **Lingfield Choosing Pathways 16+ Study Programme and Supported Internship programme**
