24/1 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

There were no declarations of interest received at this point in the meeting.

24/2 MINUTES- STAFF APPEAL COMMITTEE - 16 APRIL 2024

The minutes of the Staff Appeals Committee meeting held on 16 April 2024 were submitted and approved as a correct record.

24/3 EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

ORDERED that the press and public be excluded from the meeting for the following items on the grounds that, if present, there would be disclosure to them of exempt information as defined in Paragraphs 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 and that the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighed the public interest in disclosing the information.

The Management Representative presented their case and responded to questions asked by the Appellant, their Representative and Members of the Committee.

Following the summing up of the cases by the Appellant and the Management Representative, the Chair informed the Appellant that the outcome of the Committee's decision would be confirmed in writing to the Appellant by the Legal Services Representative.

Both parties withdrew from the meeting. The Legal Representative, Human Resources Advisor and the Democratic Services Officer remained whilst the Committee determined the appeal.

ORDERED that, having given full consideration to all of the evidence presented, the appeal against the Grievance outcome under the Grievance Policy would not be upheld.
