



- CAMHS services at West Lane Hospital was closed in 2019 following CQC regulatory action
- Formal request from NHS England/NHS Improvement (NHSE/I) to establish a CAMHS inpatient service in Teesside
- Following Board approvals CNTW agreed to provide a 10 bedded General Adolescent Inpatient Unit for young people aged 13-18 years
- 'Lotus' has been selected as the name of the ward (a symbol of regeneration) following research and engagement with young people residing within Ferndene and Alnwood Wards
- Lotus Ward will be managed by the Trusts' Specialist CAMHS Clinical Business Unit within the North Cumbria Locality Care Group
- Lotus opened on 5 April 2021 following NHSE/I approval and CQC registration
- Patient occupancy commenced 10th May 2021



What Lotus Ward offers as a General Admissions Unit?




- Support to young people who are suffering from complex mental health difficulties who require assessment and treatment
- Therapeutic support offered by a nursing team and full Multi Disciplinary Team including: Psychiatrist, Occupational Therapist; Speech and Language Therapist; and Dietician and Occupational therapy
- Individual therapeutic support such as: Dialectical Behavioural Therapy; Positive Behaviour Support; risk assessment of needs; engagement within structure clinical management; and links with the community teams
- 24 / 7 nursing support offering a wide range of activities to support recovery and promote independence, build resilience to safely return back to the community
- Young people will receive education during their admission. This will incorporate vocational skills, educational skills (link with local school/college), sports and gym facilities to promote healthy lifestyles and mental wellbeing as well as a wide range of ward based activities
- Admission of young people to the ward may be informal or via a section under the Mental Health Act
